BRIDGE TUNER FRAME REPAIR INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Completely disassemble the bridge. Remember that the saddle locking screws are left hand thread.
- 2. Use a vise or screw clamp to push the affected area flat. Use some flat pieces of hardwood to protect the bridge from damage.
- 3. When the area is flat, use water thin super glue to fill the cracks. Do this as many times as needed to fill the cracks. Be careful not to get glue on the underside of the bridge where the saddle slider rides.
- 4. Sand the area flat and fill any voids if necessary.
- 5. Scuff the bridge frame with 320 grit sandpaper and repaint with flat black spray paint.
- 6. Reassemble the bridge. Do not over tighten the saddle screws. They only need to be snug to keep the saddles in place.
