## STRING CUP REPLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS

1. Remove all strings from the bass. You can even remove the neck.
2. Examine the string cup hole for anything that might obstruct the cup installation. The cup has to be able to go all the way to the bottom of the hole.
3. Find a tool like a Phillips screwdriver that will fit into the cup snugly for the installation.
4. Use "white glue" and apply glue into the hole. Use plenty of glue.
5. Line up the string cup so that the slots line up. Begin pressing the cup in with fingers and a tool.
6. Press the cup in so that glue squeezes out and the cup is all the way to the bottom of the hole. Do not use a hammer.
7. The cup will still be above the fingerboard after pressing into place. Clean up with a sponge and water and Q tips. The top of the cup can be smoothed down to the fingerboard using a file and sand paper, or just leave it as is.

When re-installing the new strings, position the ball ends so they are not sideways.
